



# 2024 Greenie Weenie Dressage & WD All-Walk Dressage Test

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**PURPOSE:** To introduce the rider and/or horse to the Dressage arena and the discipline of Dressage and/or Western Dressage; the horse performs only at the walk. (trot/jog is optional) The rider should demonstrate correct basic position, use of basic aids, and understanding of the figures. The horse should show relaxation; harmony between horse and rider is important. The horse accepts the aids and influence of the rider.

TEST	DIRECTIVES	P	C	T	REMARKS
1. A	Enter medium/working walk – continue on centerline to C				
2. C	Turn right				
3. M-A	Medium/working walk ( <b>trot/jog is allowed</b> )				
4. A	Circle right 20 meters				
5. K-X-M	Change rein ( <b>trot/jog is allowed</b> )				
6. C	Circle left 20 meters				
7. H-X-F	Free walk				
8. F-A	Medium/working walk				
A	Down centerline				
9. X	Halt, salute				

Leave the arena in free walk. Exit at A.

**Collective Marks:**

Gaits (freedom and regularity).			
Impulsion (desire to move forward with suppleness of the back and steady tempo).			
Submission (acceptance of steady contact, attention and confidence).		2	
Rider's position and Harmony (keeping in balance with horse).			
Rider's effectiveness of aids (correct bend and preparation of transitions).			
Geometry and accuracy (correct size and shape of circles and turns).

**Participation:**

Greenie Weenie is intended for riders and horses new to Dressage and Western Dressage.

**Medium/Working Walk:**

A free, regular, unconstrained walk of moderate lengthening where horse's hind feet touch the ground in front of footprints of the forefeet.

**Free Walk:**

A gait of relaxation in which the horse is allowed complete freedom to lower and stretch out his head and neck.

**(Trot risen/Jog sitting or risen if executed)**

**Comments:**

Horses should be ridden on a light but steady contact. Greater importance should be placed upon preparation, correctness, and quality of the movements rather than the gaits of the horse and exact execution of the movements at a specific marker.
